### Protect your Drains

#### Non-Return Valves for Sewage

Property flooding can also occur from the back-filling of sewerage pipes, causing flood water to force its way in to downstairs toilets, baths, showers, basin & sink push holes or washing machines and dishwasher appliances.

The traditional solution to this problem has been to excavate a new manhole outside the property and fit an automatic non-return valve within its own chamber to eliminate the risk of backflow. This is a good but very expensive solution.

The Watersight International Non-Return Valve (NRV) is designed for quick and easy installation: it simply pushes into the end of a 110mm/4" outlet pipe where it opens from the property into an inspection chamber / manhole. The NRV allows water and waste to pass out from the property but will allow nothing back in as the valve's resting position is closed.






Retrieve flood boards from storage and wipe clean.

**2**




Remove the cover treadplate(s). Use the lifting keys for heavy steel treadplates.

**3**




Remove the poly-foam insert that protects the bottom gasket.

**4**




Close the drain bung at the side of the base frame by turning clockwise.

**5**




If the system includes a centre mullion post or intermediate posts, position post spigot into socket.

**6**




Place the bottom board into position behind the frame corner guide plates.

**7**




¼ Turn compression locks clockwise to loosely locate the pawls into the frame slot.

**8**




Add further boards, ¼ turn the locks each end to loosely locate pawls so the board cannot fall off. Click and fix together by pressing down hard one end, continue to press along the length in small steps until the boards click fully together. Check boards parallel and no gap.

**9**




After all the boards have been added turn the locks clockwise as far as possible to compress the gasket and create a watertight seal. If system includes a top rail(s), remove frame caps and position rail end spigots into the frame.

**10**




To remove the boards – ¼ turn all system locks to loosen, then one board at a time turn the locks fully anticlockwise. Standing in the middle, lean forward until the board pops off. Repeat as necessary. For the bottom board shake and lift out.

**11**



Replace the poly-foam insert, ensure the end slits locate over the corner plates so there is no gap between the insert and the bottom gasket. Replace the cover treadplate(s).

**12**



Routinely remove the treadplate(s) and poly-foam insert(s). Wash clean or vacuum the frame and gasket seals to remove dirt build up.

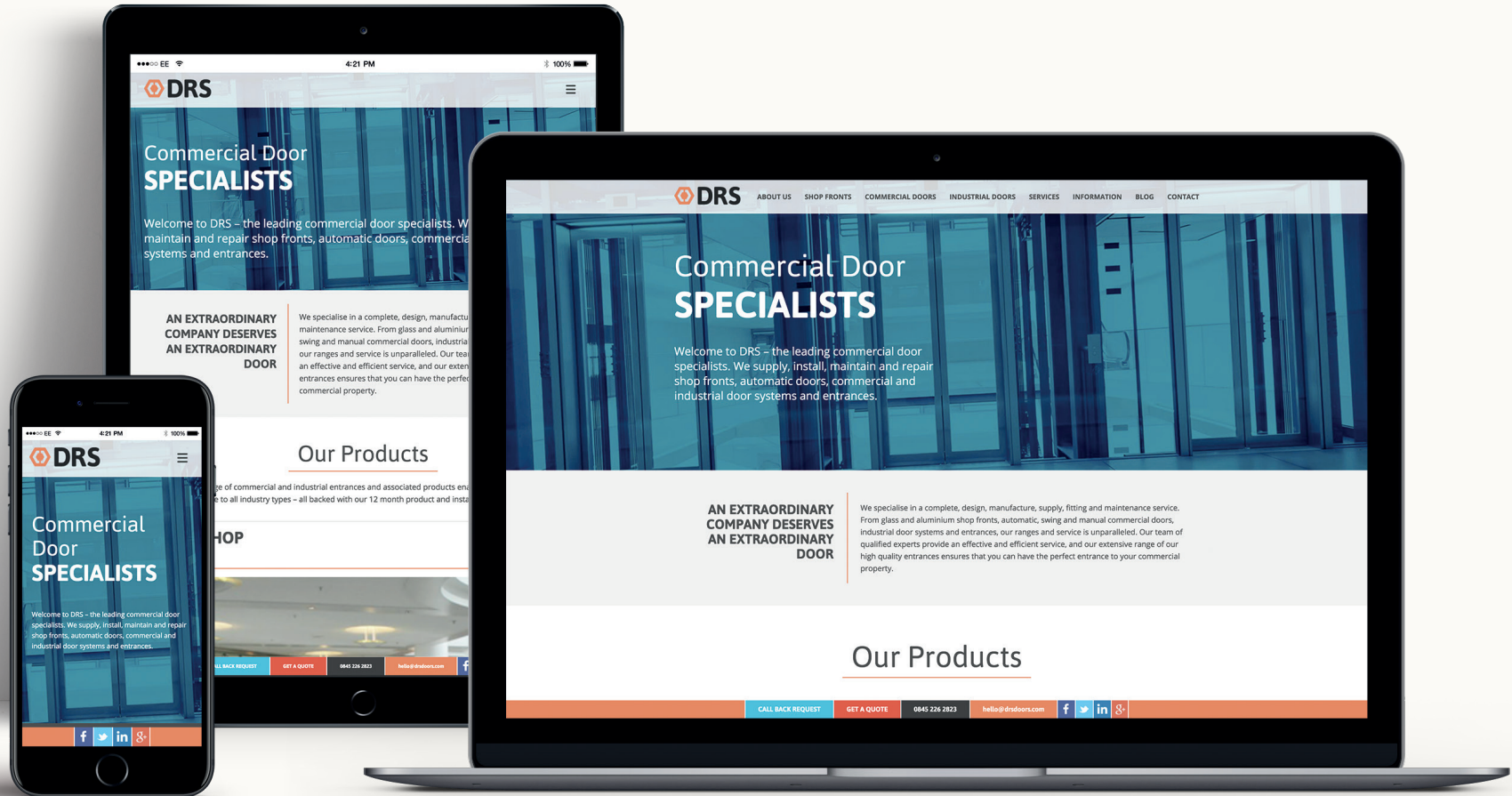

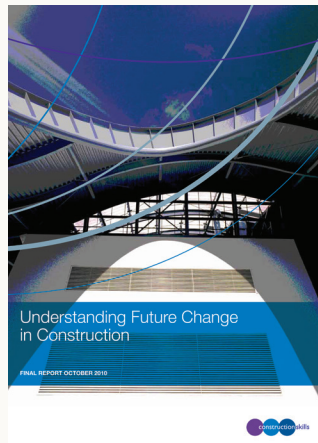

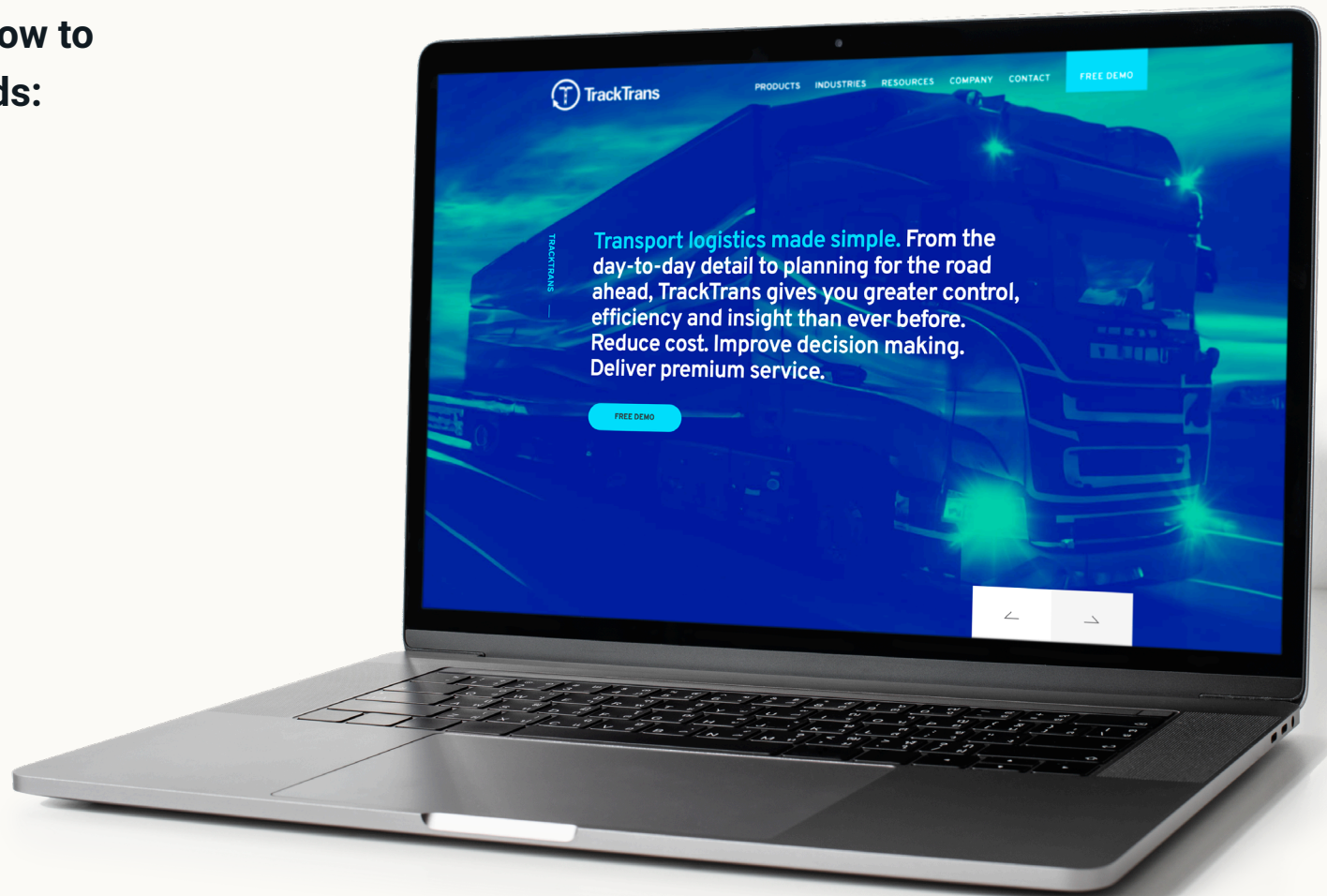
